15 partner agencies worked together to help reduce gun & gang crime in the Poly Caville & Las Vegas Trl. neighborhoods.

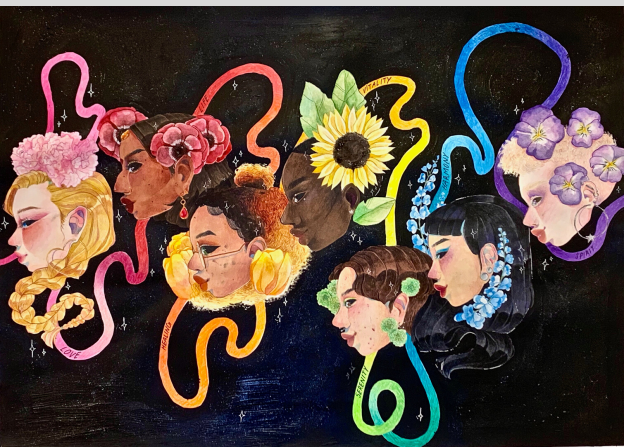


More than 20k students participated in 2018 & 188 students received monetary prizes for outstanding achievement.
